• Walker Dismissal is being changed by having designated doors; Mr. Bullis says how dismissal needs to be safer by making sure that the children are released to parents; parents can write letters to allow their children to be released without a parent to walk or ride their bikes home Parent suggestion: the door that opens to let children out shuts too quickly; needs to keep the door open a little longer than 3:25-3:30; Mr. Bullis admits it is a staffing issue and will be working out how to make it longer past 3:30 Parent asked if there is a form that needs to be filled out for dismissal: Mr. Bullis states they will be mailing home a dismissal slip so it is streamlined that everyone does it the same way when dismissal request needs to be changed;
